## DATABASES INCLUDED IN THE PACKAGE

HeinOnline's International Core package is designed to provide a base of content to meet your research needs. HeinOnline's databases are dedicated to treaties, constitutions, case law, world trials, classic treatises, international trade, foreign relations, and much more.



### Law Journal Library

HeinOnline's Law Journal Library provides a wealth of information regarding law and law-related issues, as well as in-depth analyses of important legal decisions. Unlike other online databases, HeinOnline's Law Journal Library is comprehensive, beginning with the first issue ever published of more than 3,300 law and law-related periodicals. With more than 47 million pages of articles, comments, notes, book reviews, cases, decisions, and legislation, HeinOnline's Law Journal Library bridges an important research gap.

The Law Journal Library contains legal periodicals covering more than 100 subject areas which are published in 60 different countries, as well as all 50 U.S. states and the District of Columbia. **Legal Classics\***

**Revised Statutes of Canada**

The Revised Statutes of Canada (RSC) set compiles all federal laws of Canada passed by the Parliament of Canada since confederation in 1867. It includes the periodic consolidation of the Statutes of Canada, incorporating amendments and acts that have been added since the last revision. To date, there have been six revisions: 1886, 1906, 1927, 1952, 1970, and 1985.

**Slavery in America and the World: History, Culture & Law**
